Help SSVP, Help Our Neighbours

Food Banks Canada says food bank use has increased 90% since 2019. Across the country, more than 2 million people turn to food banks **every** month.

More than 50% of food banks are giving out less food than usual to avoid running out. SSVP is not part of the formal food bank system. But the people we serve also use the Calgary Food Bank. Like them, SSVP at St. Peter's has cut back the food in our hampers.

Donations welcome: Your gifts of non-perishable food items, cash & grocery cards sustain SSVP in the months that follow Christmas. January through April are among SSVP's busiest months. We rely on Advent donations to help people through that period.

Cash & grocery cards are always welcome. We also appreciate donations of non-perishable food. Consider buying a pantry staple when you get your groceries. You or your children are welcome to leave these items in the SSVP box at the back of the pantry. Envelopes, grocery cards & cash can also be slipped into the SSVP Slot Box. It's part of the bookshelf to the left of the entrance to the sanctuary. Hamper staples include: hearty soups, canned fish & meat, PB, pasta sauce and canned beans.





ALIES is a frontline pro-life organization operating houses beside Alberta's abortion clinics, offering women a last chance to hear a compassionate, life-affirming alternative before their appointments.

Because bubble-zone legislation prevents any pro-life outreach within 50 metres of abortion providers, our private locations are the only places in Western Canada where this kind of personal, immediate support is possible.

Since 2006, we know of **218 babies saved, including 13 this year.**

We are now fundraising to purchase a house in Calgary so we can extend this refuge to more women. Our mission depends entirely on the generosity and prayers of Albertans and Canadians who share our commitment to defend life. **We need to raise \$240,000**, about half of the sale price.
