PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

WHERE MANAGEMENT MEETS MISSION: A FAITHFUL APPROACH

Last week, the newly formed Finance Council gathered for its first meeting. Moments like these serve as a reminder that administration in the life of the Church—when viewed through the eyes of faith—is never merely about structures or procedures. Rather, it becomes a concrete expression of the Body of Christ in action: discerning together, walking together, and faithfully stewarding what the Lord has entrusted to this parish community.

Church administration plays a vital role in supporting the mission of the Church. When exercised wisely, it safeguards the credibility of the Church's witness, fosters trust among the faithful, and strengthens the implementation of pastoral initiatives. Properly understood, administration becomes a ministry—one that enables the Church to proclaim the Gospel, celebrate the sacraments, serve the poor, and build communities rooted in communion and service.

A Ministry, Not a Corporation

While Church administration calls for competence, responsibility, and planning, it must never be reduced to business management. Its foundation is the Gospel, and its goal is mission. The Church operates for the advancement of God's Kingdom. Decisions must be made in a spirit of discernment, always seeking what serves the good of People of God and remains faithful to the Church's identity.

The key question is not only What works? but also What is faithful? In the Church, success is not measured only by numbers or efficiency, but also by fidelity—to the Gospel, to the promptings of the Holy Spirit, and to the real needs of the community. Every budget discussion, every maintenance decision, and every pastoral plan should reflect the deeper purpose of communion, mission, and service.

SHARING THE WORD

Gospel Reading - John 8:1-11

The emphasis on newness from the first two readings today reaches a climax in Jesus' encounter with the woman caught in adultery. Jesus' response is typical, drawing out with razor sharpness what he considers core values in word and deed: holiness is found in compassion and understanding, reflecting the ways of God. There is no room here for judging others harshly while being lenient on oneself.


- 1. Are you comfortable with Jesus' treatment of the woman?



The second scholarship will be awarded to a student currently attending a post-secondary accredited institution.


The successful candidate(s) will be a male student(s) who has balanced his academic achievement, as well as parish involvement and participation in community activities and ministries.


PRAYER CHAIN

MOTHERS' FELLOWSHIP


Come join other moms for an evening of prayer and fellowship.
