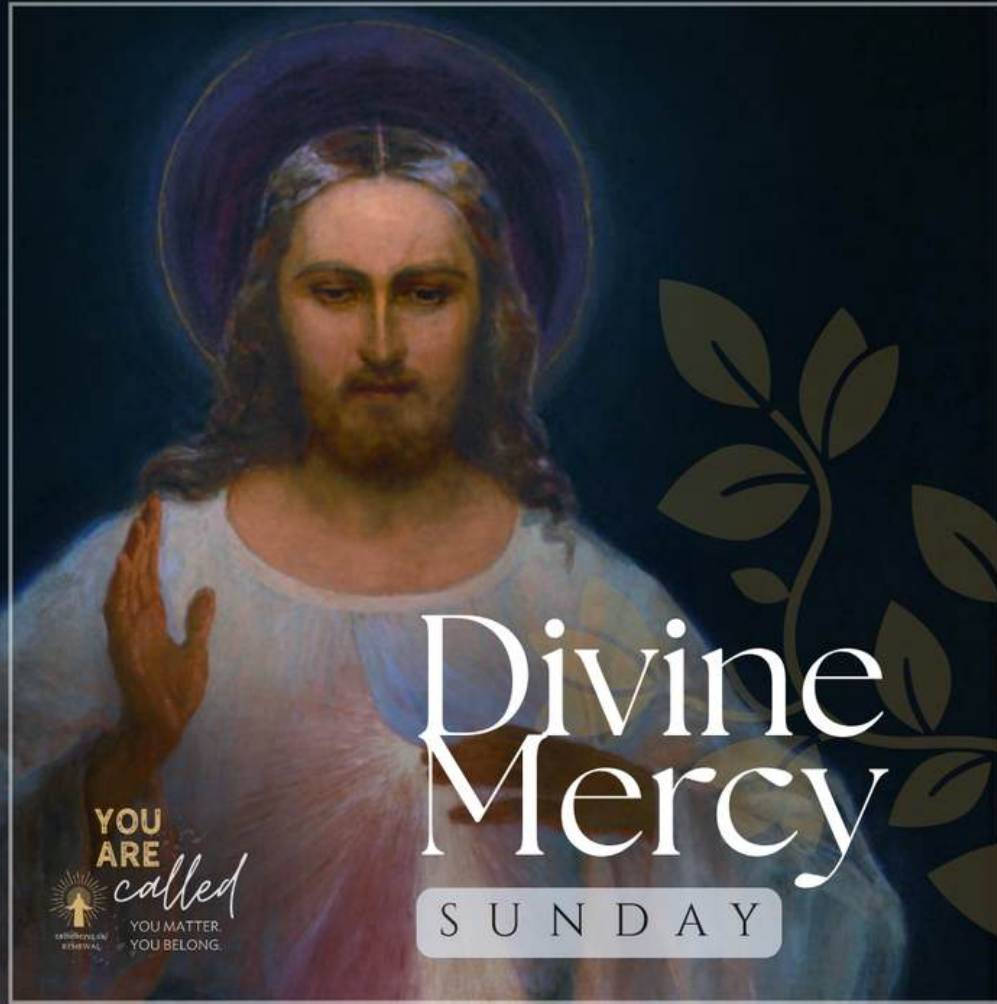

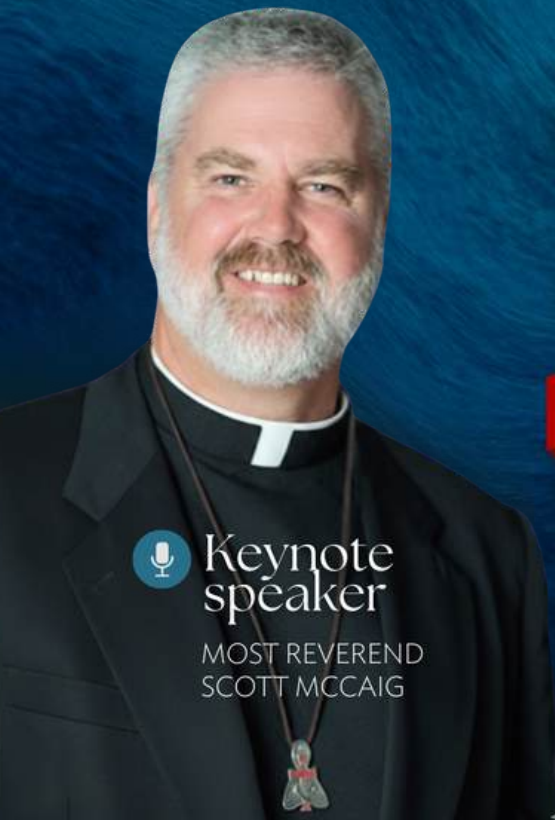

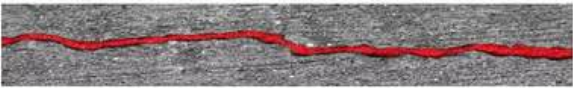
RED SAND CEREMONY

IWIN Initiative
I'm worth it now

There will be a Red Sand Ceremony on Sunday, April 19th after the 11:30 am Mass. All CWL members are encouraged to attend and all parishioners are invited.

IWIN, working with human trafficking investigators, provides backpacks to survivors who are entering a wrap-around program to support them emotionally, physically and spiritually. The backpacks, containing all brand new items, include a change of clothes, toiletry items, a handwritten card of encouragement and a bracelet. A matching bracelet is given to a volunteer prayer warrior to support the survivor through prayer.

IWIN also raises awareness about the atrocity of human trafficking and its prevalence right here in our home country of Canada by providing volunteers with the opportunity to participate in a Red Sand Prayer Service.



IWIN stands for I'm Worth It Now - We want survivors to know that it doesn't matter what their past looks like; it doesn't matter what their future looks like; they are worthy of love and respect NOW!

Donations benefit the Building Fund & the hungry

Divine Mercy Sunday

April 12 is Divine Mercy Sunday. As we celebrate God's abiding mercy, we also give special thanks for those who help SSVP at St. Peter's in our ministry to serve the vulnerable.

+\$6,700.

That's how much money SSVP contributed to the St. Peter's Building Loan in 2025.

Those funds were raised by direct grocery store gift card purchases for hampers. (That does NOT include funds raised by benefactors who purchased grocery cards, then donated them to SSVP.)

\$12,000.

In February, SSVP pre-purchased grocery cards for 2026. Thanks to matching gifts that quadruple SSVP's contribution, the amount paid to the Building Fund tallies about \$12K.

Parish School Donations

St. Ambrose, St. Basil, St. Brigid, St. Maria Goretti, St. Rita's and St. Sylvester schools all led generous Lenten food drives for SSVP. Our shelves—and hearts—are full!

God Bless the Confirmands

Young people approaching confirmation have volunteered with our bread program since February. God bless every one of you—and the parents who helped get you to and from the pantry. Several families have opted to join that program. We are grateful!

SSVP is a volunteer-run organization funded by the faithful. At St. Peter's, benefactors enable Vincentians to put healthy food on the tables of about **60 families** a month. SSVP's largest food hampers cost more than **\$180**. That food is supplemented by grocery store gift cards.

All donations over \$25 qualify for a charitable tax receipt.

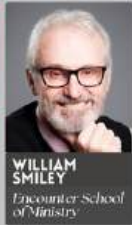
