PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE


Beloved St Peter's family,

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Jesus seems to be utilizing a bit of comic relief in this parable by taking a common experience such as a wedding and turning it into a very uncommon wedding experience by extrapolating the possibilities of what could happen. Matthew runs a theme in this Gospel that actions outdo words in most any situation. As St. Francis of Assisi says "act in love and use words when necessary". He is actually explaining the Gospel message that Christ brings to us.
