# YEAR 3 OF PASTORAL RENEWAL The Action Plan Phase

After two years of listening, reflection, and preparation, we now begin **Year 3 of Pastoral Renewal — The Action Plan Phase.** 

This is the moment when our shared vision takes shape through **concrete initiatives** that renew parish life and strengthen our mission.

Together, we now move from reflection to action, turning inspiration into lived witness within our parish communities.



#### **Breaking Isolation, Building Communion**

Following many meetings with parish representatives, fostering communion and breaking the spirit of isolation, we rediscover that no parish is an island, and no ministry is a silo.

The dedicated work of the Parish Renewal Teams in each community has helped transform dialogue into direction and faith into coordinated action.

#### **Rooted Locally, United in Mission**

#### **Guided by the three diocesan priorities**, discerned together:

- 1. Forming missionary disciples,
- 2. Becoming a Church of encounter and witness, and
- 3. Strengthening family life,

The 68 parishes in Southern Alberta are now invited to move forward with its own plan, rooted in its local reality yet united in one common vision.

#### One Church, Walking Together

The Diocese, understood not as an administrative center but as the Church's teaching defines — a portion of the People of God entrusted to the bishop and his priests, and with the collaboration of the lay faithful —

journeys together as one Church, guided by the Holy Spirit, walking together toward the renewal of our faith, our communities, and our mission in Christ.








# A TASTE OF ST. PETER'S




