# **PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE**

# WHOSE VOICE SHAPES OUR STEPS? Listening beyond ourselves to discern God's path

To discern is more than to decide. It is the art of recognizing whose voice is shaping our steps. At times, we are drawn by the quiet influence of our ego, which convinces us that what is comfortable or advantageous must also be right. Other times, we are misguided by the evil one, who disguises false paths in garments of light. And often, we lean on the voices of others — voices we trust — and yet they can quietly shape us in ways that hold us back. Even voices we know well can confine our vision, keeping us from God's wider horizon.

God's voice does not restrict us within what is narrow. His will is never a closed room, but a doorway. It frees us to live in what truly matters: caring for family, building up community, serving others, and responding to the needs of the world.

Discernment is never secure if it rests only on my self-perception or within the circle of familiar influences. Without this clarity, we risk being guided by the whispers of the ego, the tricks of the evil one, or the comfort of familiar voices. But when we have the courage to listen together — praying, speaking, and seeking God as a parish family — our vision grows clearer. In that shared listening, the Spirit grants us a perspective none of us could reach alone.

This is how we are called to live as a parish: real collaboration grows out of communal discernment. We need to leave room for the movement of grace, which carries us beyond our own preferences. In the flow and crossings of community life, we are invited to give priority to this inspiration — the guide who shows us the right path at each moment of our history.



# Advancing Truth and Reconciliation in our Parish



The St. Peter's Truth and Reconciliation Action Committee (TRAC) invites you to the fifth and final viewing and discussion, using a Canadian film production entitled Bones of Crows. This builds upon on the sharing circles held last spring to better understand how the personal, community and social effects of the Indian Residential School System continue through today. Pope Francis urged us to take on this work during his pilgrimage to Canada and by the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Call to Action #59.

Bones of Crows is a story of resilience and strength told through the eyes of Cree Matriarch Aline Spears. Removed from their family home and forced into Canada's residential school system, young musical prodigy Aline and her siblings are plunged into a struggle for survival. Over the next hundred years, Aline and her descendants fight for a more just future.

A sweeping drama grounded in historical truth, Bones of Crows weaves together underrepresented moments in Canadian and Indigenous history, including the Indigenous contributions to WWII, the ongoing cases of Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls and the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada.

The episodes and the ensuing sharing circles will cover challenging material and so will not be suitable for children.

This final session will be on Saturday, September 27 from 9:30 to 11:00 in room C. Please join us as we learn together.
