




SUNDAY REFLECTION

SHARING THE WORD

Gospel - Luke 24:35-48

The word "companions" refers to those who break bread together. There is a special unity among those who share food. The gospels contain many examples of this special bond formed when Jesus shared food. It is not surprising then, that in sharing food, Jesus continues to reveal his presence among us. The disciples on the road to Emmaus were slow learners, but once they grasped the meaning of Jesus' presence in the breaking of the bread they also grasped the meaning of his suffering and death.

- 1. What was the disciples' first reaction upon seeing the risen Jesus? Have you experienced similar shock in your own relationship to Jesus?
- 2. How has your faith grown from seeing the wounds and scars of another?
- 3. Name a conversation moment you have had recently. What made it significant?

We presently have 5 Residential or Care Communities that we provide weekly Lay-Led Liturgies of the Word with Communion Service as well. There is also a service for Graduated Supports in Bowness, arranged between the coordinator and the staff.

Mass is celebrated in each of these communities once a month with one of our Parish Priests.

Some of our members take Holy Communion to people in Hospitals as well as help with Masses in those Communities.




