#### Who are the Vulnerable?

Data from the Calgary Food Bank shows 69% of hamper recipients have a monthly income.

35% receive fixed government benefits (like Alberta Works/long-term disability), 22% are working and 12% are on AISH (Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped).

A COVID-19 rule change sets NO limits on the number of hampers people receive.

Still, 62% of the hamper recipients use the service fewer than 3 times a year.
