PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

PASTORAL RENEWAL PLANNING: UNITING IN COMMUNION, SENT IN MISSION

Saint Peter's Parish is embarking on a journey of pastoral renewalnot as a mere administrative task, but as a spiritual process rooted in prayer and discernment. This renewal calls us to shift from maintenance to mission, aligning our ministries with Christ's command to make disciples. As part of the Pastoral Renewal Plan of the Diocese of Calgary, we seek to be a living witness of faith, communion, and shared mission.

Having established our pastoral structure by organizing ministries around the core areas of parish life, we now enter the second phase of this journey. This phase involves deepening our commitment by prayerfully discerning concrete actions that will shape the mission of our parish.

To advance this mission, our parish and ministry leaders are engaging in a structured process of prayer, assessment, and action planning. Through Lectio Divina and ministry evaluation, each group will discern ways to strengthen evangelization, discipleship, and the spiritual growth of those who serve. The resulting action items will guide ministry renewal and outreach, ensuring that our parish life remains centered on communion and mission.

Pastoral renewal is an ongoing process of conversion. Ministry groups will continue to meet, refining and implementing their plans, while the Parish Renewal Team integrates these efforts into the broader vision. This process will unfold during the Parish Life Area Meetings, scheduled for April 1 and April 3.

SUNDAY REFLECTION SHARING THE WORD

Gospel Reading - Luke 9:28-36

Carefully worded, Luke's account of the transfiguration is placed at the eve of Jesus' journey to Jerusalem. For Luke, Jerusalem is the central place of faith where Jesus spoke his first recorded words, where he completes his ministry, suffers his passion and rises, appears to the apostles, ascends into heaven, sends his Spirit, where Peter preaches his first sermon, and where the great commissioning takes place. For Luke the transfiguration then opens up the entire mystery of the incarnation – God the Word-made-flesh – and of God's salvation for all in Jesus Christ.

2. If you were to witness the events at Mount Tabor, to actually see the "dazzling white" gown of Christ would your relationship change with Jesus, and how?





All donations over \$25 qualify for a charitable tax receipt.



Advancing Truth and Reconciliation in our Parish

The St. Peter's Truth and Reconciliation Action Committee (TRAC) invites you to a fivepart series of discussion and learning, using a Canadian film production entitled Bones of Crows. This builds upon on the sharing circles held last spring to better understand how the personal, community and social effects of the Indian Residential School System continue through today. Pope Francis urged us to take on this work during his pilgrimage to Canada and by the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Call to Action #59.

Bones of Crows is a story of resilience and strength, grounded in historical truth. It weaves together underrepresented moments in Canadian and Indigenous history, including the Indigenous contributions to WWII, the ongoing cases of Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls and the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada.

The episodes and the ensuing sharing circles will cover challenging material and so will not be suitable for children. The discussion after the airing of the first episode on February 22 was both thoughtful and sincere.


CELEBRATING THE WORD
