Advent Expectations & This Is My Church Campaign

A New Moment of Hope and Renewal for Our Parish

As we approach Advent, we want to thank you for your generosity and for your active presence in the life of St. Peter's. This year, **our parish has lived something extraordinary: a renewed sense of communion, faith, and shared purpose.**

At the start of 2024, our post-renovation loan was still \$5.2 million. For eight years, the monthly payments have strained our resources and limited what we can dedicate to ministry, mission, and parish life.

But since launching our Building Fund campaign in March, everything has begun to change. Week after week, your gifts, sacrifices, and steady commitment have breathed new hope into our parish. An anonymous donor has quietly doubled every contribution, multiplying the impact of each act of generosity.

Now, as we enter Advent, an unprecedented opportunity stands before us. The Diocese is launching a debt-forgiveness program, offering to forgive 15% of our remaining debt when we repay 15% — essentially doubling every dollar we put toward repayment.

Combined with your generosity and the ongoing matching support, **this creates a once-in-a-generation moment for St. Peter's.** What initially began as a financial campaign to pay off the debt in 5 years has now become an **opportunity to be debt-free by March 31, 2026.**

On the First Sunday of Advent, we will present full details of the diocesan program and our roadmap from Christmas to Easter — a plan that can lead us to a true turning point in our parish's journey.

Thank you again for your generosity, your commitment, and your faith. You are strengthening St. Peter's and helping in setting our mission for the future.




ST PETER'S BUILDING MAINTENANCE COMMITTEE


