#### SUNDAY REFLECTION

Two groups are at the foot of the cross: those who recognize Jesus as King, and those who oppose and taunt him. We find both believers and opponents hanging next to and standing below the cross. This scene is a summary of Luke's entire Gospel: Jesus offers salvation and reaches out to those who ask, and who recognize their need for redemption. Thus, even though Jesus' kingship exists on a cosmic level, it is an established fact: in this life only our assent in faith reveals that kingship.

- What does the title "Christ the King" mean to you?
- Where in the world, our larger world, do we see signs of Christ's kingdom being built?






