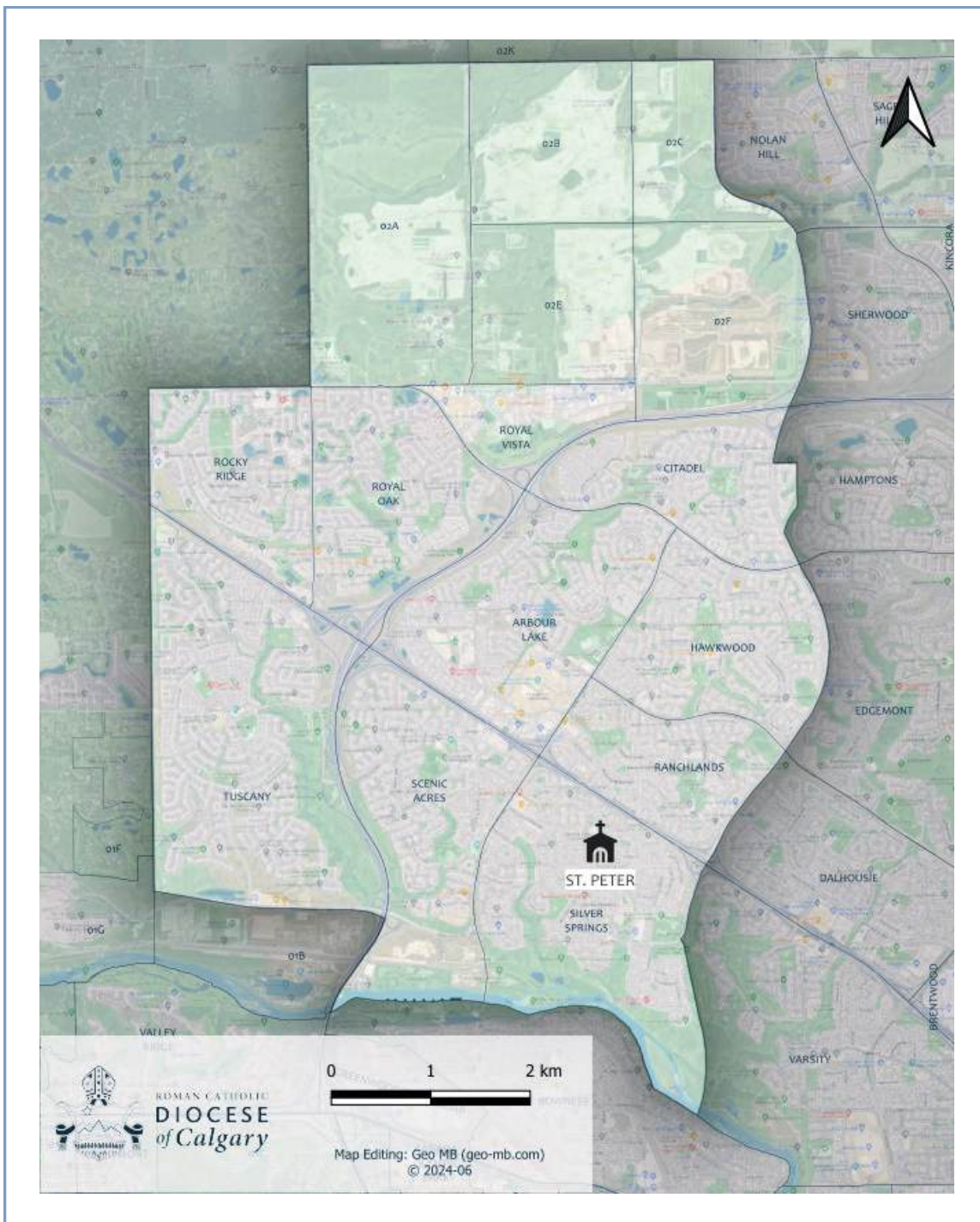
And as we move forward, the invitation remains the same:

Our Parish Community

The parish of St. Peter's was established in 1977 by Bishop Paul O'Byrne. Fr. Stan Henke was appointed as the pastor to be in charge of overseeing the building of the church.

The first Mass was celebrated on September 18, 1977 in the Silver Springs School Gymnasium. On December 31 of that same year, the parish moved over to St. Sylvester School Gymnasium and then in July of 1978, they moved into Atco trailers which held approximately 285 people.

Construction on the current building was completed in January 1984.

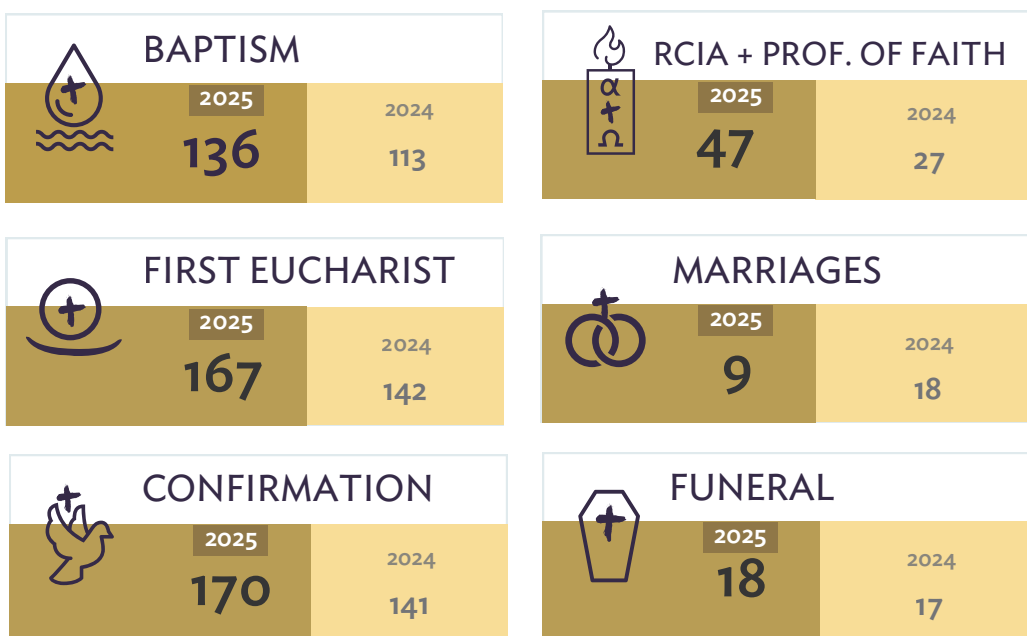

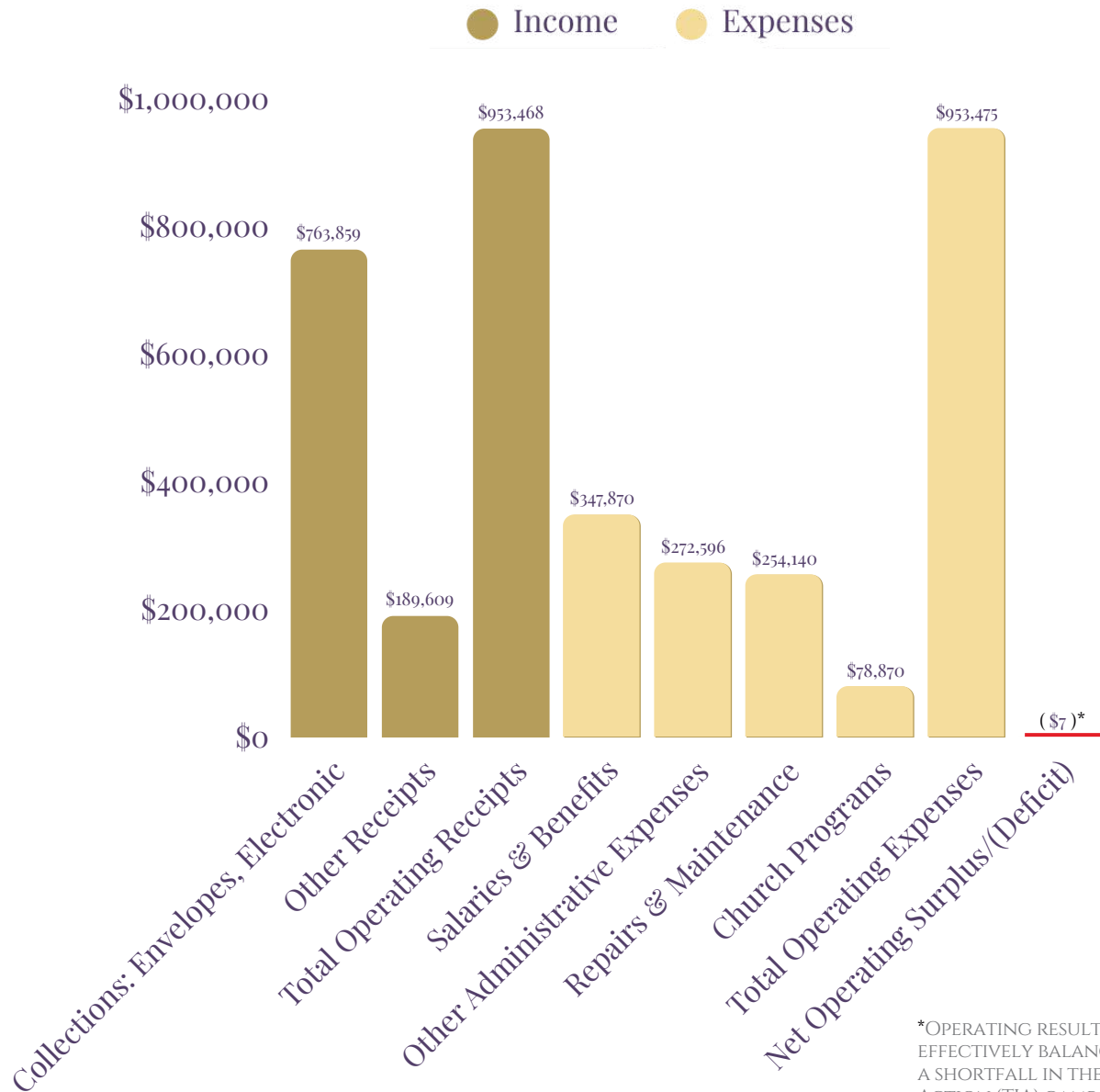

Parish Financial Summary Operating Income and Expenses



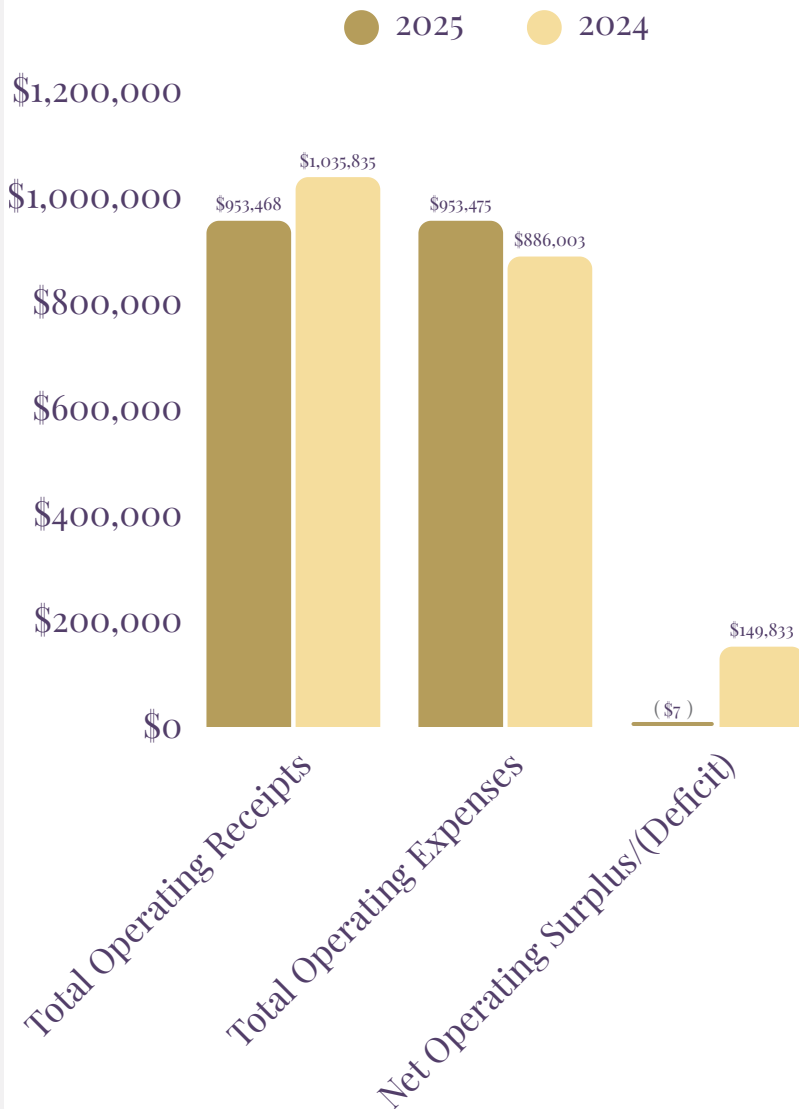

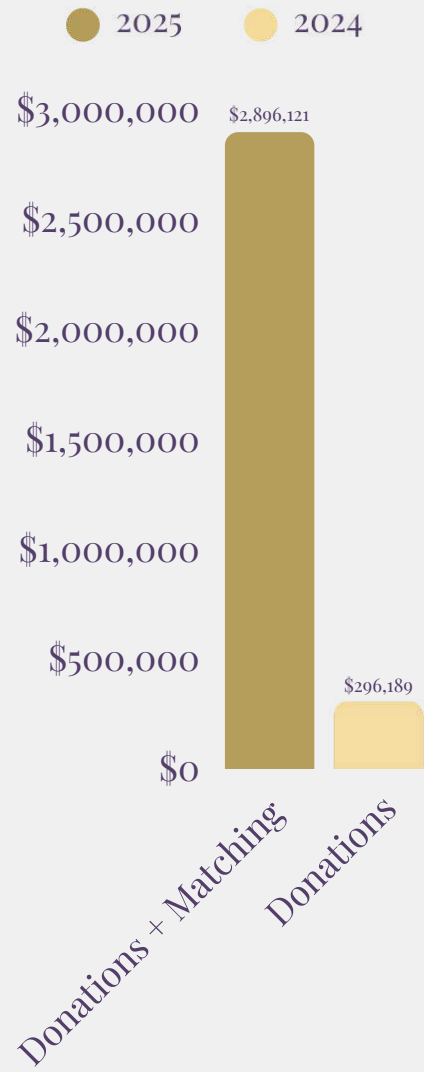

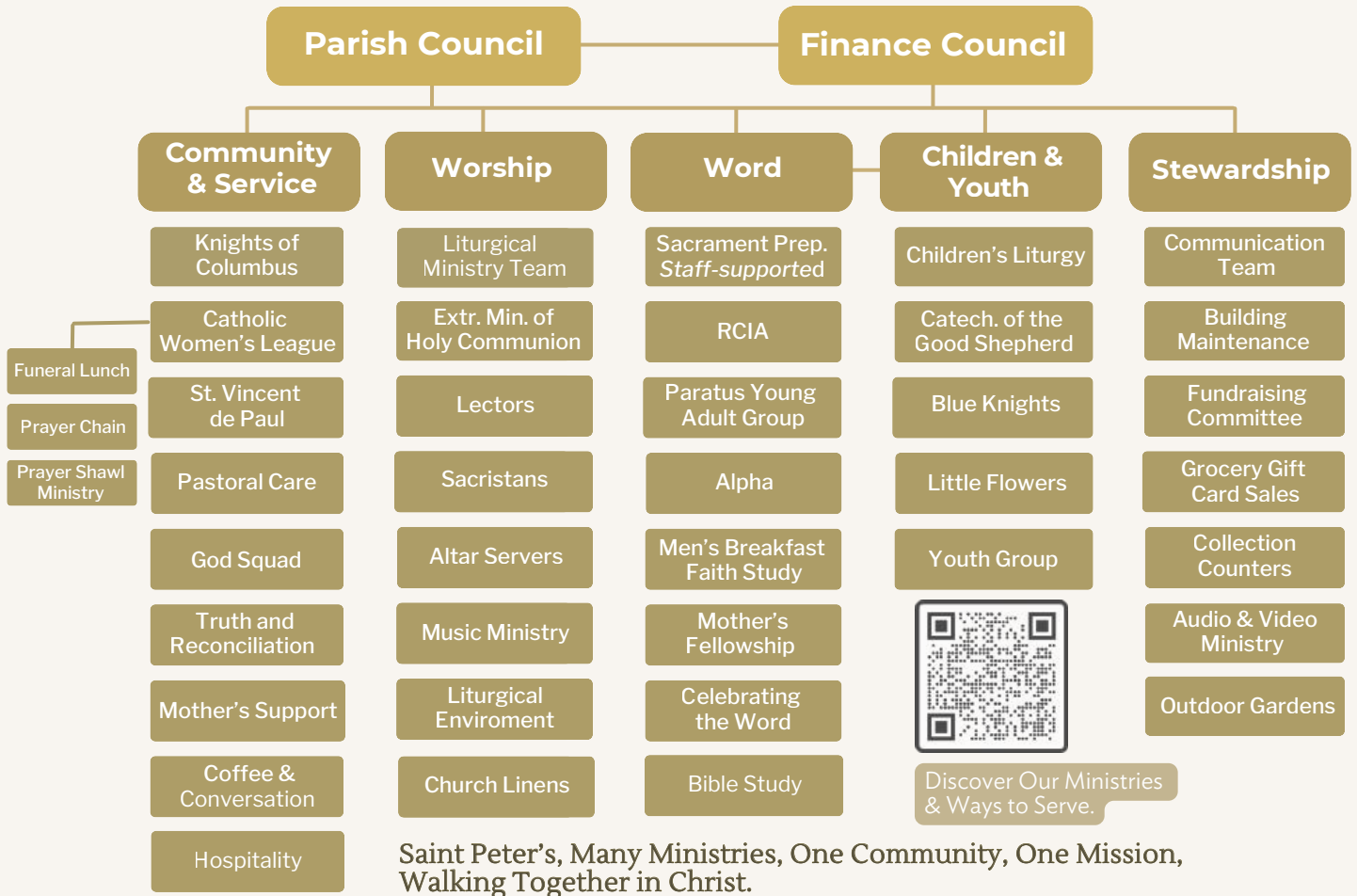
