Walking Together in Christian Charity, Communion, and Shared Responsibility

As a community of faith, we recognize the **Word of God as the highest norm of Christian life**. In the Gospel, we learn how to live our calling, relate to one another, and walk together in Christ. This same Word reminds us that **our shared ministry is not merely a set of tasks**, but an expression of faith, generosity, and communion. Through our pastoral service, we care for the life and mission of our parish community, always **seeking to serve with charity and respect for the dignity of each person**.

In this light, the Diocese of Calgary offers the **Code of Pastoral Conduct and Accountability for Volunteers** as a **concrete expression of what the Gospel asks of us**. This guidance for our pastoral ministries reminds us that everyone who serves is called **to treat others with respect, patience, integrity, courtesy, dignity, and consideration**. This care should guide our words and actions, **including in-person interactions, emails, text messages, and every form of electronic communication**.

To help safeguard the spirit of communion within each parish community, **certain situations may call for further attention**, especially when conduct seriously affects the dignity, respect, or well-being of another person. **When this happens, the matter should be brought forward** through the appropriate parish and diocesan channels, so that it may be considered with care, fairness, and prudence, **with a view to addressing what is needed** and reaffirming the way we are called to serve in parish ministry.

As we carry forward the mission entrusted to us, may this gentle reminder **help us strengthen the spirit of communion** in our parish life. Through our words, our actions, and the way we care for one another, may we **continue to build a community marked by charity, respect, and trust**.

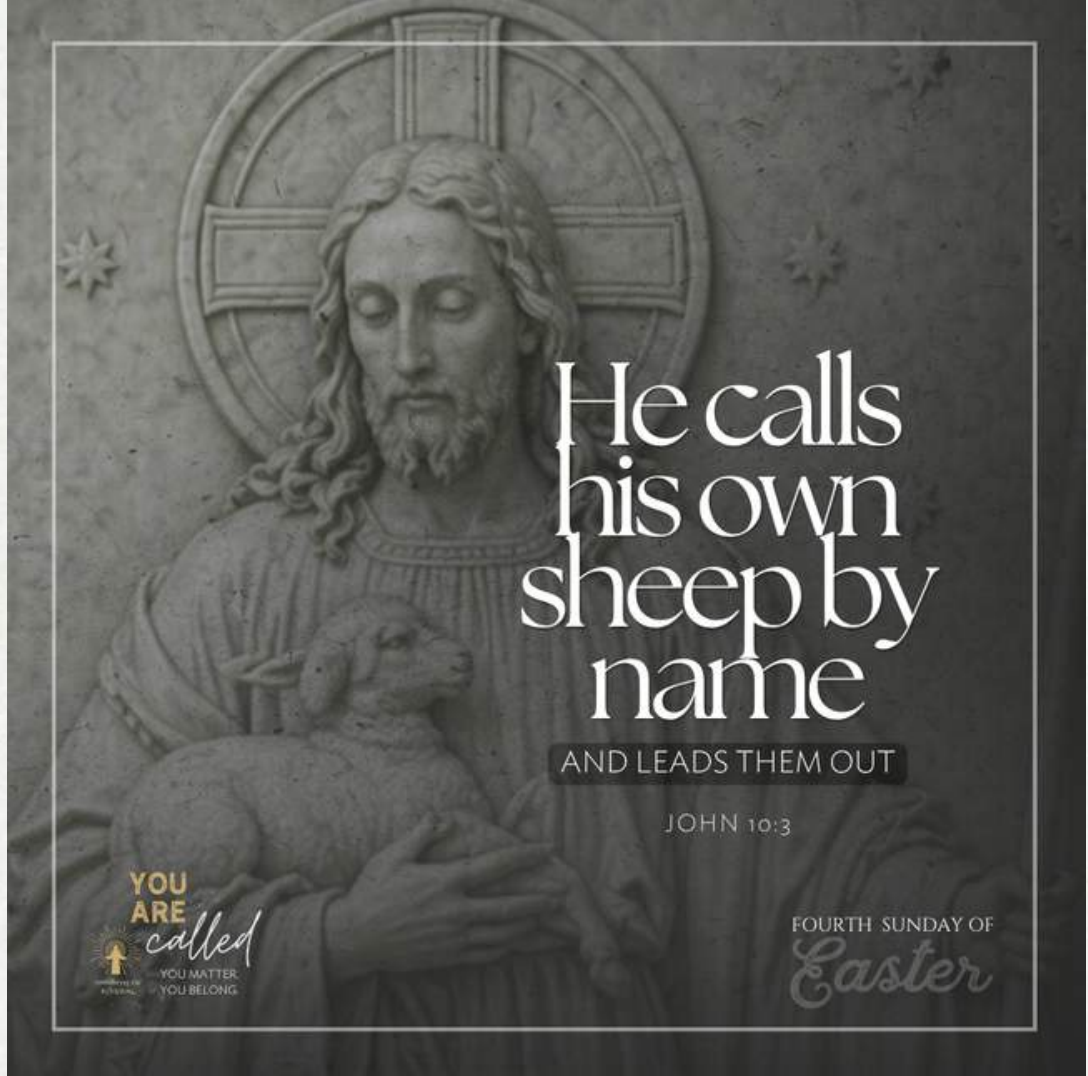

Healthy Food For Hungry People

SSVP knows that many people who need food won't ask for it. That's why Vincentians take such good care to deliver food assistance with kindness and dignity.

In 2025, our direct food costs tallied **about \$7,100 a month**. School food drives and non-perishable food donations help keep those costs down. That total does not include the cost of gift cards that are included in every hamper.
