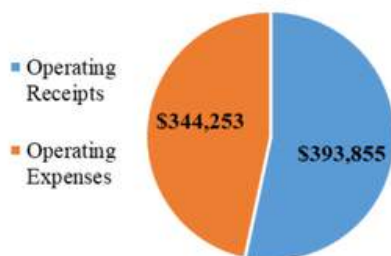

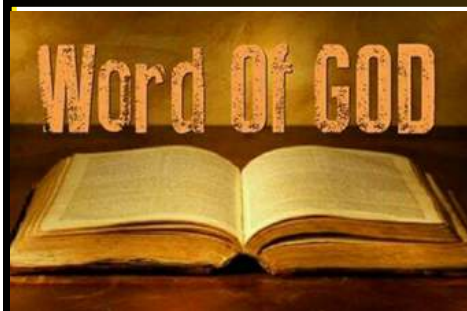

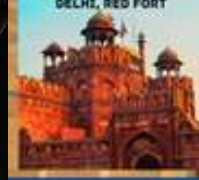

Divine Mercy booklets will be provided, and we invite you to consider reading one of the 7 Sorrows. Sign-up sheets before Mass begins.

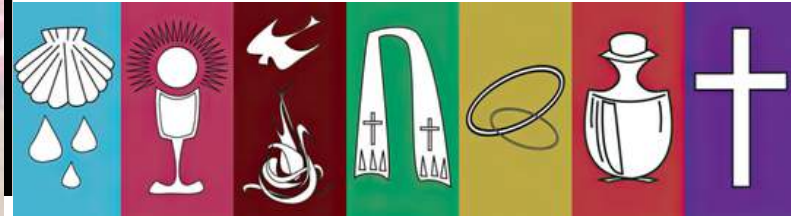
