

- Welcome and Thank you for taking the time to join us for this Building Renovation Update.
- This information session is part of St. Peter's commitment to providing open communication and dialogue regarding your spiritual home.
- There are 3 objectives to this update are to communicate:
- 1. 'WHY' the building renovations are necessary
- 2. The current building renovations and cost
- 3. The status of the 'Rock of our Faith' campaign



- We're here to celebrate the completion of the first phase
- But first let's understand 'WHY' St. Peter's expansion is necessary.
- St. Peter's is the **fastest growing** parish in Calgary See #7 in the map above.
- In 1977, St. Peter's began with Catholic meetings in various school gymnasiums. When the church opened in 1984, it served 2 communities. Today, we serve more than 12.
- Parish boundaries include 7 schools—5 more than the 2 it served in 1984!
- In 2014, Bishop Henry announced St. Peter's would be the last Catholic church built in northwest Calgary.
- The only option left for us is to renovate and expand St. Peter's Parish.

"To put it simply, we did not have the space requirements to meet the needs of the spiritual demands we are facing at this time. By providing larger spaces for gathering, more options for meeting rooms, people will have the option to take in what the church has to offer," Fr. Jerome.

Why focus on the former rectory first?

In the short run, the addition of extra Masses on Saturdays and Sundays were an easy fix to help our priests minister to the growing numbers of faithful. But as the parish expanded, so did demands on parish support for the faithful.

- •About 4,500 families are registered with St. Peter's. About half of these attend regularly. Others who have never registered also attend our Masses and bring their children to our programs.
- •To meet their needs, St. Peter's now has a Sacramental Team comprised of 3 part-time staff and many volunteers.
- •Now that Phase 1 renovations are soon to be completed, we will have faith formation groups for every age group in the parish. These will range from Children's Liturgy to Sacramental prep, youth groups, Bible study and prayer groups.
- •St. Peter's has one of the largest Catholic Women's League in Alberta with 226 members and one of the largest Knights of Columbus councils with 200 members.
- •We have one of the Diocese most active music ministries. Close to 150 parishioners participate in our choirs!
- •How did St. Peter's manage all of this growth? Faith Formation groups had been meeting in the Narthex. RCIA nights had been cancelled when there were conflicts. Choirs had to compete for times to rehearse. Other groups, like the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, couldn't even use the church for meetings.






Here are some details surrounding the new building renovations:

Administrative space for our 13 staff and numerous volunteers to support the fastest growing parish in the Diocese.



The 3 Upper Level Meeting Rooms consist of a Board Room with seating for 12, and a Conference Room with seating for 30 that can be split into two. One room will have state of the art A/V capabilities. A third meeting room includes a Break-Out Room to support our Sacraments and Faith Formation teams.




The new *Music Room* will support the 150-plus people in our music ministry. This room is equipped with various instruments, microphones, rehearsal seating and storage and A/V and recording capabilities.

- 1.Accessible Washrooms & Handicap Elevator Easier to use for people with mobility issues
- 2.HVAC: Heating and air conditioning will be operated more efficiently and is now in place for all phases.



Parking Lot

St. Peter's Property





- The Parking lot expansion needs to be completed before any further expansion is started.
- The parking lot capacity plays a key role in 1) Making close access to the Parish a
 priority for more parishioners and 2) Establishing the seat capacity for the expanded
 sanctuary.
- Our goal is a) To build 30 more parking stalls on the green space behind the Church, and b) To expand the main St. Peter's parking lot from 150 to 190 parking stalls. This, along with street parking would provide us with a total of 250 parking stalls.
- WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT: This parking lot expansion to 250 parking stalls needs to be done prior to any work starting on any future phases in other words, this parking has to be completed before any permits from the City of Calgary can be approved for the next phase of renovation or development.



- A Grotto to Our Blessed Mother is being built on the south side of the office area of St. Peter's.
- The Grotto will feature this beautiful statue of Mary as well as a 'Rosary' pathway lined with flowers, trees and shrubs.
- This area will provide a space for prayerful meditation for everyone at St. Peter's.

Identified needs for building renovations:

- •A shortage of office / administrative space, meeting rooms, and a music room
- •Critical importance of accessible washrooms an elevator to accommodate people with disabilities & aging population
- •The HVAC system was inadequate and did not operate efficiently.

Necessary Upgrades and add-ons included:

- •Unforeseen fire protection sprinkler system now in place for all phases
- •Upgrade water hook up to the church to a 6" Water Main rather than the current 2".
- Asbestos removal
- Security system now in place for all phases
- •Support / reinforce bricks that were peeling away from the building
- •Floor & roof
- •Windows that were 'residential' quality were replaced with 'commercial' quality
- Storm water drainage
- •Saint Vincent de Paul added new flooring and door upgrades
- Parish Hall windows and new Narthex windows
- •Flooring for large corridor and replacement of flooring for Narthex and Parish hall.
- •Upgrades to lower level Conference Room (old Don Bosco Room)
- Parking Lot, Landscaping & Grotto
- •The cost for the Building Renovations as of July 1, 2017 is \$5 million dollars.
- •The necessary upgrades and add-ons builds in future expansion efficiencies,

modernizations and better prepares and aligns these renovations with the next phases of renovations.



- Thank you to all our supporters of the Rock of our Faith campaign especially in these tough economic times.
- Our costs for the building renovations are \$5M so far.
- How are we paying for these costs?
- \$1.66M has been pledged and donated to date from 510 donors. This amount includes a one time donation of \$350K from the General Fund.
- We need to borrow \$3.34M from the Diocese of Calgary
- Bishop Henry describes St. Peter's as bursting at the seams. "We've got to do something. This is the most obvious answer," says Bishop Henry of the expansion plan. The Rock of our Faith Campaign is reaching out to the entire St. Peter's community, inviting every individual and family to share in the opportunity to contribute to the future of our church"!
- We continue to ask parishioners for their financial support for the cost of these renovations



Did you know?





- 15% of all regular donations to St. Peter's Parish are tithed to the Diocese.
- 100% of all Building Fund Donations stay with St. Peter's.
- All donations are eligible for a charitable tax receipt.
- Purchasing pre-paid grocery cards through St. Peter's is a great way to support the Building Fund. To date we have sold over \$255,000 worth of cards with a commission to us of over \$21,000.
