WHO IS MORE BLESSED?

Our gospel for today must be the shortest in the Lectionary, it only had two verses

long. But listening attentively to the message, the impact will be tremendous. If you read

all the four gospels, only St. Luke offers the balance between male and female disciples.

He took a note of anything about women's disciples. On this particular gospel and

particular occasion, the brief exchange between Jesus and a nameless woman is reported

only by St. Luke wherein the a woman was so overwhelmed by Jesus that she

spontaneously burst out with a word of praise for Jesus' mother, whom she declared as

highly blessed, for being the mother of such a son. The woman's remarks pictured about

the love, care, concern and life of Mary. The kindness and goodness of Mary reflected in

the kindness and goodness of Jesus.

Jesus Christ regarded Mary, His mother with high esteem but He transferred the

woman's word of praise to a wider group. He said: "Blessed rather are those who hear

the word of God and obey it." The Blessed Mother belongs to that wider group. She

heard the word of God with love and enthusiasm, kept and live it. She professed that

when angel Gabriel visited her and answered the invitation to be the Mother of God: "Let

it be done to me according to your word." She gave herself to God by doing God's word

throughout her entire life.

So, my brothers and sisters, if like Mary, we dedicate ourselves to hearing and

doing God's word, we will be blessed just as she is. Let us always listen and do God's word

today and everyday.
